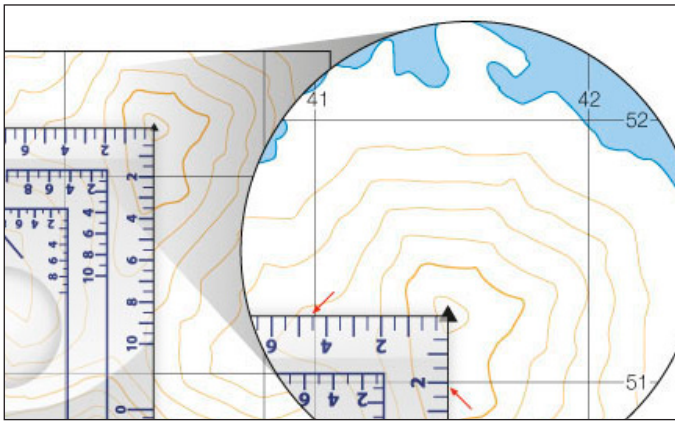
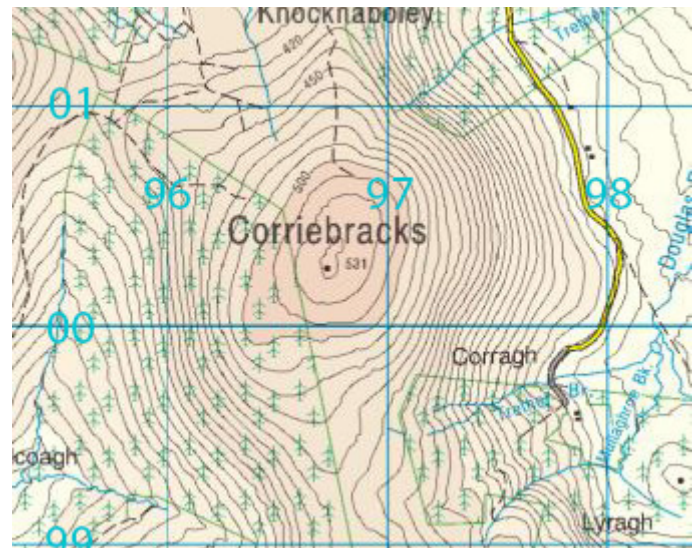


Mountain Skills Grid Reference Work Sheet



Grid references start with a letter followed by six numbers. A romer is used to measure the grid reference. Place the corner of the romer on the required point and read off the figures that align with the grid on the map. The sample above, using a 1:25k scale map and romer, gives a reading of 41**4** 51**2**. This provides a 100 square metre grid reference.

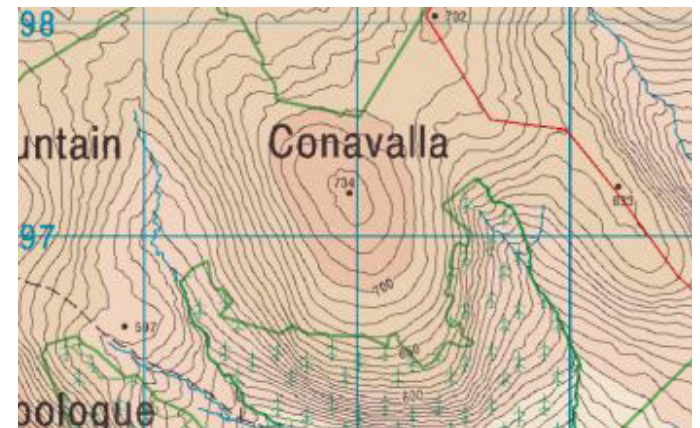


Example: Corriebracks Summit (531mt) -
 National Grid Letter: **N** Easting: **96** Northing: **00**
 Place the corner of a 1:50k Romer on the summit
 this reads **7 & 2**: Grid Reference: N 967 002



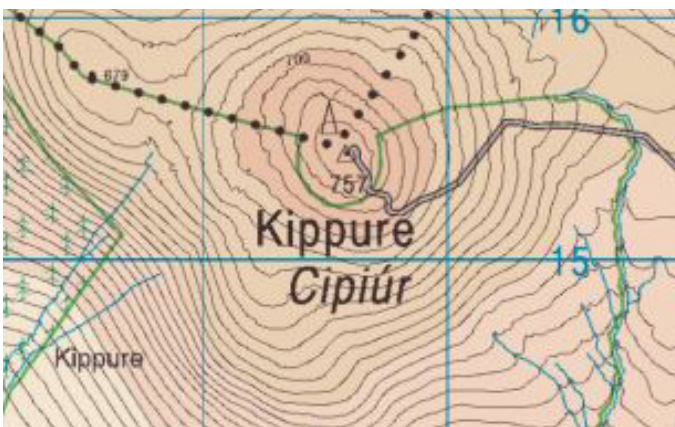
Tonelagee Summit (817) Map OSI 56. Scale 1:50k

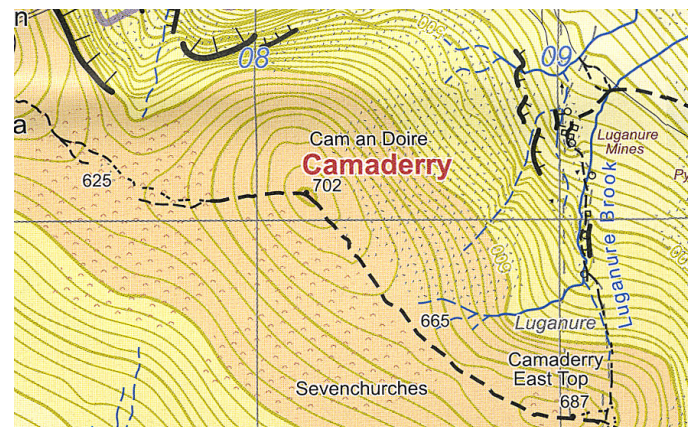
